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About the Club

The Economic Club of New York is a membership organization with Members drawn from the top executive levels of business, industry, and finance. Founded in 1907, the Club serves as a major forum for discussion on a wide range of public issues of interest to business people. The Club is non-partisan and a 501(c)(3) non-profit. Its individual Members represent a wide diversity of opinion.

The Club promotes no agenda, and it takes no position on issues. It exists solely to provide a serious, structured forum in which selected top leaders, from both the U.S. and abroad, can address its Members and their invited guests. Because its speakers have complete freedom to express their views, the Club is described as the leading non-partisan forum in the United States. All views expressed at Club functions are those of the speakers, not of the Club.

Speakers are chosen for distinction and timeliness. Over the years speakers have included heads of government, cabinet ministers, legislators, economists, bankers, business executives, labor leaders, university presidents, governors, judges, generals and admirals, ambassadors, and scientists.

Our virtual events, breakfasts, lunches, receptions, and occasional dinners are informative and enriching exchanges with world class and highly influential thought leaders. The program itself is uninterrupted and the event's entire focus is on the Guest of Honor. Programs include a Q and A session, commonly in a fireside chat format to include questions from Members of the Club.

Club programs are open to Members and their guests. Members are encouraged to invite guests, and many find that hosting tables at in-person events provides a unique opportunity for their clients. Club events are typically open to coverage by the media. As part of our Reciprocity Program with the Economic Club of Washington D.C. and the Economic Club of Chicago, their upcoming events are shared with ECNY Club Members for their consideration to attend on a complimentary basis.

The Centennial Society, available to those in the Club who are elected to membership, includes advanced tiers of giving that reflect our most generous Members. Special benefits of joining the Centennial Society vary by giving level but include recognition in Club materials, priority seating for Members and their guests at in-person events, as well as the ability to bring a guest to the VIP receptions, invitations to the annual Salon Series, special receptions for Centennial Members, and much more.

Membership Information

Full Membership

Members are chosen from senior leaders, typically C-Suite, who have distinguished themselves in the areas of finance, technology, law, government, academe, media, healthcare, real estate and other economic sectors. This membership class requires proposal from two current Members in good standing.

Membership Dues Packages

The Club offers four distinct Member Dues and Events Packages including: **Standard Annual Dues Package:** annual membership dues at \$1,400, plus a one-time initiation fee of \$1,450 upon acceptance by the Membership Committee; **Digital Package:** annual membership dues plus unlimited digital events for \$2,400; **Silver Package:** annual membership dues plus unlimited digital events, plus four in-person events selected by member for \$3,500; **Gold Package:** annual membership dues plus unlimited digital and in-person events for \$5,500 and **Platinum Package:** annual membership dues plus access to all events (in-person and digital) for Member & one Guest per event for \$8,000. Annual dues are prorated by month and both annual standard dues amount and initiation fees are fully tax-deductible.

Associate Membership

The Economic Club of New York offers a five (5) year term membership for individuals 45 years of age or under that are in mid-level or above leadership position with a minimum of seven (7) years professional experience, demonstrating upward mobility and a successful track record. This membership class facilitates deeper familiarity with the Club, networking opportunities and the ability to attend Club Member events. Associate Members are encouraged to attend a minimum of three (3) Club events annually. Associate Members are only required to have one (1) current member proposer in good standing and go through the same membership process as the Full Membership class. After the five (5) year term, Associate Members may apply for Full Membership but there is no guarantee of admission.

Membership Dues

For this five (5) year term membership Standard Annual Dues are \$950. A one-time initiation fee of \$950 is also required of new Members upon their acceptance by the Membership Committee. Annual dues are prorated by month and both annual standard dues amount and initiation fees are fully tax-deductible.

In addition to Standard Annual Dues, Associate Members may choose one of our four Dues and Events Packages: **Digital Package:** annual membership dues plus unlimited digital events for \$1,950; **Silver Package:** annual membership dues plus unlimited digital events, plus four in-person events selected by member for \$3,050; **Gold Package:** annual membership dues plus unlimited digital and in-person events for \$5,050 and **Platinum Package:** annual membership dues plus access to all events (in-person and digital) for \$7,550. Annual dues are prorated by month and both annual standard dues amount and initiation fees are fully tax-deductible.

Virtual Non-Resident Membership

Members are chosen from senior leaders, typically C-Suite, who have distinguished themselves in the areas of finance, technology, law, government, academe, media, healthcare, real estate and other economic sectors. This new membership class requires proposal from one current Member in good standing. Non-Resident Members must live and/or work outside of the New York Metro Area (NY, NJ, CT). Non-Resident Members will have access to register/invite guests to virtual events and can attend/invite guests to in-person events at the guest ticket price.

Membership Dues

The Club's standard annual membership dues are \$800. A one-time initiation fee of \$750 is also required of new Members upon their acceptance by the Membership Committee. Annual dues are prorated by month and both annual standard dues amount and initiation fees are fully tax-deductible.

In addition to Standard Annual Dues, Non-Resident Members may choose one of our four Dues and Events Packages: **Digital Package:** annual membership dues plus unlimited digital events for \$1,800; **Silver Package:** annual membership dues plus unlimited digital events, plus four in-person events selected by member for \$2,900; **Gold Package:** annual membership dues plus unlimited digital and in-person events for \$4,900 and **Platinum Package:** annual membership dues plus access to all events (in-person and digital) for \$7,400. Annual dues are prorated by month and both annual standard dues amount and initiation fees are fully tax-deductible.

Membership Application Procedures for All Membership Classes

1. The applicant should complete the application form and sign as indicated.
2. The Associate Membership and Non-Resident Membership require one (1) proposer. Full Membership requires two (2) proposers. The proposer and the seconder should be named on the application form as indicated.
3. When choosing a proposer and seconder from the membership of the Club, one may be from the same organization as the applicant. In all cases the proposer and the seconder should be from different organizations.
4. The proposer and seconder should each send a letter or email supporting the applicant. These letters should be emailed to gmfeazelle@econclubny.org or mailed to The Club's office.
5. Along with the application form, the applicant should also provide a photo (which will not be shared outside of the ECNY Membership) and a separate biographical statement. The information on this should be sufficient to give the Membership Committee an understanding of the applicant's professional background and significant public activities, if any, together with a brief capsule of whatever else the applicant might deem relevant.
6. The complete packet consisting of: The proposer's and seconder's note of recommendation; the signed and completed application form; and the biographical statement, will be presented to the Membership Committee.
7. The applicant, the proposer and the seconder will all be notified when the Membership Committee has taken action on the application.
